As the Committee of the Franciscan Family for the Franciscan Centenary, we address and invite all of you to participate and promote participation, in person or online (on the centenary website www.centenarifrancescani.org), in the celebration on the anniversary of promulgation of the *Later Rule*.

This celebration will be held in Rome, at the Basilica of St. John Lateran, on 29 November 2023 at 3.00 pm.
